



NEEDS-BASED SCHOLARSHIPS

SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES

PURPOSE

The purpose of need-based scholarships is to help make a faith-based education more accessible to families who demonstrate financial need.

REQUIREMENTS

- Family must be current on tuition payments.
- Students must demonstrate Christian behavior and adherence to the school's mission statement.
- Student must demonstrate consistent, satisfactory academic and behavioral performance.
- A completed need-based scholarship application through Clarity must be submitted.

TERMS OF SCHOLARSHIP

A family that receives a need-based scholarship should be aware of the following terms of the scholarship award:

1. Scholarship Duration & Renewal

- The scholarship award is effective only for the applicable academic year. • Families must reapply each year to be considered for future financial aid.

2. Enrollment Requirement

- The scholarship remains valid only if the student is actively enrolled in AHS Worldwide.
- If the student withdraws, any remaining scholarship funds will be forfeited.

3. Academic Performance Requirement

- The student must maintain passing grades (C- or higher) in all classes.
- Failure to meet this requirement may result in scholarship reduction or revocation.

4. Adherence to School Mission & Policies

- The student must demonstrate a good-faith effort in adhering to the school's mission and policies.

5. Non-Transferability

- The awarded scholarship amount cannot be transferred to another student or family.

6. Tuition Account Status

- The family's tuition account must remain current and in good standing.

7. Service Commitment

- Scholarship recipient families agree that a parent or guardian will complete at least 10 hours of approved service during the academic year.
- Service opportunities may include monitoring virtual student lunch periods, assisting with online events, supporting family engagement activities, or other approved service opportunities.

8. Confidentiality

- Scholarship awards are confidential and should not be discussed with others.

9. Tuition Payment Method

- Families receiving financial aid are expected to use automated payment methods that reduce administrative costs for the school.

10. Third-Party Scholarships & Educational Funding

- Families receiving educational funding from third-party sources, including school-choice scholarships, ESA programs, or other tuition assistance programs, must notify AHS Worldwide promptly.
- The school reserves the right to adjust scholarship awards in consideration of such funding.

11. Future Giving & Gratitude

- We encourage families who later find themselves in a position to contribute to AHS Worldwide's scholarship program to do so.
- Until then, we invite scholarship recipients to express their gratitude through service and positive participation in the AHS Worldwide community.
